

## HENLEY ON THAMES TOWN COUNCIL

### MILL LANE (OFF STREET PARKING PLACE) ORDER 2008

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Henley on Thames Town Council proposes to make the above Order under s57-59 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and under section 35 of that Act as applied by section 59 of that Act, the effect of which will be to regulate the use and set the tariff of charges to be made at the Council's Mill Lane off street car park.

The nature and effect of the Order is to introduce charging for parking in Mill Lane car park in order to relieve and prevent congestion and to preserve local amenities.

The Council proposes to introduce charging as follows.

The Council also proposes to introduce excess charges (fines) of £70 and £35 with reductions to £35 and £20 for early payment eg within 14 days.

The Council may offer season tickets
