

March 2013 Nomad Report.



Nomad provide a targeted service for vulnerable youth and families, (particularly families who have children aged 10-19) in the local community, which provides structure for strengthening families and promoting positive parenting/ healthy life styles. The Nomad Team develops and delivers a range of programmes that engage with and support in the areas of substance misuse, self-esteem, behaviour related issues, anger management, communication, education, employment, relationships and making good life choices.

This has been a year of challenges, some successes, some disappointments, but also a year to be proud of. On average we see between 300-400 targeted interventions per month. The money provided by the Town Council is an essential part in enabling Nomad to continue to support many young people and families in the town. Below is a list of the current services we provide:
