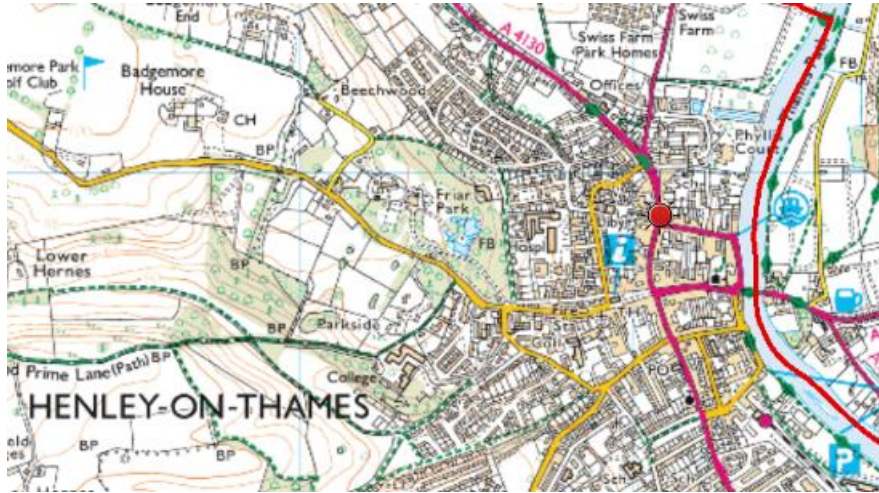


Proposal for 2no new Bollards outside 71 Bell Street, Henley

Location:



Reported situation:

71 Bell Street is a listed residential property that has recently been renovated and, one part of this, saw the refurbishment and redecoration of the property frontage. The area lies within the Henley Conservation Area.

The property is located between retail premises consisting of a pet shop to the South and a country pursuits / equestrian store to the North. Next door to the equestrian business is a take away baguette bar.



The owner of the property reports that vehicles regularly bump up the kerb and wait / park along this stretch with 'one wheel on and one off the footway. In one instance something has scraped the front of the property.



Considering the above, and to discourage vehicles mounting the kerb it is suggested that two Cast Iron Bollards, matching those already in place in Market Place, be installed within the two locations marked with the white dots in the photo:



The locations will still maintain easy access for pedestrians, buggies and wheelchairs using the footway.

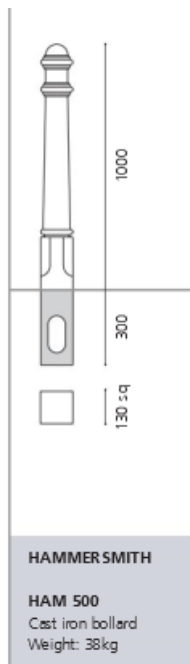
The Details of the Bollards are (with a Red/White top band) and pre-finished in Black Gloss:
